### What's been going on in Year 3 & 4...

This Spring term has been an extremely enjoyable term for Year 3 and 4. We have been learning all about living things and processes in Science and the children have absolutely loved creating their pop-up cards. We have used our creative thinking caps by understanding what each feature of the cards does.

In English, children have been frequently working in groups to role play certain acts of the stories which we have been focusing on. This has allowed them to develop confidence in performing as well as develop on drama skills.

In Maths, we have focused on various different topics to enhance our numeracy and number skills. We continue to practice our times tables and want to become more fluent in them.
